ORDER:

In the letter first read above, the Director for Welfare of the Differently Abled has stated that the Ramakrishna Mission Vivekananda Educational and Research Institute (RKMVERI) Coimbatore, a deemed to be University as declared by the Government of India, has informed that they have proposed to conduct the following courses:-

2. The above courses are proposed to be offered in furtherance to achieve the objectives of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 and the Institution is supplementing the activities of the Government in fulfilling the obligations of the Act.

3. The Institution has requested the Government to sanction the following as expenditure per annum for starting the above said courses:-

Though the total cost requirement for commencing the courses work out to Rs.7.90 Crore, since the Institution has requested to sanction only a sum of Rs.4.55 Crore per annum for conducting the above said courses, the Director for Welfare of the Differently Abled had recommended that a sum of Rs.4.55 Crore may be sanctioned per annum to the institution for commencing the courses.

5. On examining the proposal, the Government have decided to accept the recommendation of the Director for Welfare of the Differently Abled and sanction a sum of Rs.4.55 Crore (Rupees four crore and fifty five lakhs only) per annum to the Ramakrishna Mission Vivekananda Educational and Research Institute (RKMVERI), Coimbatore for conducting the following courses:-

The above annual grant of Rs.4.55 Crore shall be for a period of five years from the academic year 2021-2022 and the efficacy of the course like number of persons enrolled for the courses, number of persons who have completed the course and recommended for placements and the overall impact of the Welfare of the Differently Abled will be reviewed after the end of the period of five years. The Director for Welfare of the Differently Abled is authorized to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Ramakrishna Mission Vivekananda Educational and Research Institute and the Director for Welfare of the Differently Abled must ensure that the indicators for the performance of the courses and the institution are clearly mentioned in the Memorandum of Understanding. On assessing the performance as mentioned in the Memorandum of Understanding, the Director for Welfare of the Differently Abled will release the grant year after year. The Director for Welfare of the Differently Abled will also ensure that the Institution possess a valid approval for conducting the courses from the Rehabilitation Council of India while sanctioning the grant.

6. The Grants sanctioned in para-5 above shall be debited under the following new head of account opened under B.P. No.52-02:-

7. The expenditure sanctioned in para-5 above shall constitute an item of "New Service" and the approval of the Legislature shall be obtained in due course of time by an inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2020-21. The Director for the Welfare of Differently Abled shall send necessary draft explanatory notes for inclusion of this expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2020-2021 at the appropriate time without fail.

8. The Director for the Welfare of Differently Abled is the Estimating, Reconciling and Controlling Authority of the above New Head of Account. The Pay and Accounts Officer / Treasury Officer concerned is directed to open the above new head of account in their book.

9. The Director for the Welfare of Differently Abled is requested to send necessary proposal for release of funds from the year 2021-22 onwards, after entering into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Ramakrishna Mission Vivekananda Educational and Research Institute, Coimbatore.
